Winespectator ratings are based on four criteria: quality (represented by score); value (reflected by release price); availability (measured by case production or cases imported); and an X-factor they call "excitement".

90/100 – Pure by Pech de Jammes 2009 – 49\$

Finely etched, with powerful flavors of dried red berry, dark plum, mocha and spice. There's a refreshing minerality in this as well, which extends into the crisp, dark chocolate-infused finish.

Drink now through 2018 – 150 cases made K.M

88/100 – Château Pech de Jammes Grand Vin Seigneur 2009 – 25\$

A refined style, with ripe, firm flavors of blackberry and mocha that feature accents of black olive and chocolate. Offers a crisp, spice-filled finish.

Drink now through 2016 – 950 cases made K.M
